Requirements:

- 1. All work must be conducted in compliance with Chapter 62-761, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C) and Section 24-45 of the Code of Miami-Dade County.
2. Attach site sketch showing location of tanks, on-site buildings, and adjacent streets.
3. All storage tank system components removed must be properly cleaned and disposed of in accordance with American Petroleum Institute RP 1604 and National Fire Protection Administration 30. The contents of the tank must be properly recovered and disposed of by a ERM permitted waste transporter.
4. Discovery of new contamination requires submission of a Discharge Report Form to DERM. Chapter 62-761 requires the owner to immediately contain, remove and abate the discharge.
5. The DERM inspection coordinator 305-372-6600 must be notified two working days in advance to schedule the require inspection. The groundwater must be made accessible for the inspector.
6. Removal of a storage tank system regulated by Chapter 62-761 requires the submission of a Tank Closure Assessment Report (TCAR) to the DERM within 60 days.
