





#### Do you currently have access to the internet at home?






#### **COVID-19 Vaccine: Race/Ethnicity**


## **Employment Before COVID-19**




## **Economic Impact of COVID-19: Race/Ethnicity**

Has your income been negatively affected by the economic impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic (e.g., including job loss, reduced hours, others)?






### Future Transit Investments: Under 18 and 18-24 by **Race/Fthnicity**








